

## WALLACE COMMUNITY COLLEGE SPARKS FOUNDATION FALL 2024 SCHOLARSHIPS

The WCC Sparks Foundation offers a limited number of scholarships for new and currently enrolled students. Listed below are the individual scholarships available, the duration of each award, and the special requirements for obtaining and maintaining each scholarship.

**CHARLIE BELFLOWER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** - A scholarship for **\$500** will be awarded on the basis of the WCC Sparks Campus Foundation Scholarship recommendations to a **single parent** (preferably a woman applicant) who demonstrates a financial need. *(This scholarship is non-renewable)*

**EUFAULA/BARBOUR COUNTY CHAMBER SCHOLARSHIP** - Two (2) **\$1,000** scholarships will be awarded to an Alabama resident enrolled in one of the following programs: Engineering Graphics and Animation, Welding Technology, Applied Engineering Technology, Business and Office Information Processing Concentrations, or Computer Information Science Concentrations. The applicant must demonstrate a financial need. *(Renewable spring semester)*

**EUFAULA PHYSICAL THERAPY SCHOLARSHIP** - A **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates a financial need. Preference will be given to a student majoring in the Physical Therapist Assistant program. *(Renewable spring term)*

**FIVE STAR STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP** - Four (4) **\$1,250** scholarships will be awarded to a Wallace Community College (WCC) Sparks Campus student majoring in an academic transfer, health science, or career technical program who demonstrates financial need. *(Renewable spring)*

**SPARKS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS** - Three (3) **\$750** scholarships will be awarded to students who demonstrate a financial need. *(Renewable spring)*

**WCC SPARKS CAMPUS DIRECTORS' SCHOLARSHIP** - A **\$750** scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates a financial need. *(Renewable spring term)*

**ELTON B. STEPHENS, SALES, SALES MANAGEMENT AND MARKETING SCHOLARSHIP (EBSCO)** - A **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in one of the College's business programs. The recipient must be a **Barbour County** resident. *(Renewable spring term)*

**LAURA ASHLEY STOREY MEMORIAL NURSING SCHOLARSHIP** - A **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a **Barbour County** resident who has been accepted into the practical nursing or associate degree nursing program. **(Applicant must show proof of acceptance into the program.) The recipient must have no other financial assistance.** *(Renewable spring term)*

**GET THE TASSEL SCHOLARSHIP** - This scholarship is given by the WCC Sparks Campus Foundation Board to support the Get the Tassel initiative. One scholarship of up to \$500 will be awarded for tuition, fees, and/or books to a student who is completing the last semester of their program of study with less than 12 credit hours. Recipient must have completed the graduation application in Admissions and demonstrate financial need. *(This scholarship is non-renewable)*

**MIRANDA BROOKINS WATSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** - A **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates a financial need. Preference will be given to a student majoring in the child development program. *(This scholarship is non-renewable)*

**JOEL P. AND ANN SUTTON SMITH SCHOLARSHIP** - A **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a **Barbour County** student. The recipient of the scholarship must demonstrate financial need. *(Renewable spring term)*

**BURT AND ELIZABETH SMITHART SCHOLARSHIP** - A **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a **Barbour or Bullock County** student who demonstrates a financial need. *(Renewable spring term)*

**BROWDER AND FLORENCE CAMP BEASLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** - A **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a **Barbour County** resident. *(Renewable spring term)*

**BUSH/WILLIS SCHOLARSHIP** - Two (2) **\$500** scholarships will be awarded to students who demonstrate a financial need. *(Renewable spring semester)*

**ROBERT M. DIXON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** - A **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates a financial need. *(Renewable spring term)*
